## Employee request for Equal Pay Registration Data (pursuant to the Illinois Equal Pay Act of 2003)

The Illinois Equal Pay Act allows individuals who are currently employed by a business that, pursuant to 820 ILCS 112/11, obtained an Equal Pay Registration Certification to request that the Illinois Department of Labor provide anonymized data showing the pay rates of their employer's other employees who work in the same county as the requester and who share the same job title or classification as the requester.
