CONSENT DECREE

Petitioners Operative Plasterers' and Cement Masons' Local 18 and Mark Winkler as Member of Operative Plasterers' and Cement Masons' Local 18 ("Petitioners"), Respondents Jane R. Flanagan, Director of the Illinois Department of Labor, and the Illinois Department of Labor ("Department"), and Bricklayers and Allied Craftworkers International Union Local No. 8 ("BAC Local 8"), by and through their authorized representatives, resolve the above-captioned matter pursuant to 56 Ill. Admin. Code 120.540 as follows:

1. This matter arises under the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act ("IPWA"), as amended, 820 ILCS 130/0.01, *et seq.*
2. On July 15, 2026, the Department published prevailing wage schedules establishing prevailing wage rates for classifications throughout the State of Illinois, including the Cement Mason classifications applicable to Logan County, Illinois.
3. On August 6, 2026, Petitioners filed an Objection and Request for Section 9 Hearing pursuant to Section 9 of the IPWA, 820 ILCS 130/9, objecting to the prevailing wage determinations applicable to the Cement Mason classifications in Logan County.
4. Petitioners' objection asserted that the prevailing wage rates published by the Department did not reflect the correct wage and fringe benefit rates for Cement Mason work

performed in Logan County. Petitioners requested that the Department correct the prevailing wage determinations for the Cement Mason classifications for both Building ("BLD") and Highway ("HWY") work in Logan County to reflect the wage and fringe benefit rates negotiated under the applicable collective bargaining agreements of Operative Plasterers' and Cement Masons' Local 18.

5. BAC Local 8 acknowledges and agrees that, for purposes of the prevailing wage determinations at issue in this proceeding, the wage and fringe benefit rates established by the collective bargaining agreements of Operative Plasterers' and Cement Masons' Local 18 are the appropriate prevailing wage rates for the Cement Mason classifications in Logan County, Illinois. BAC Local 8 and Local 18 agree and acknowledge that members of Local 18 perform at least thirty percent (30%) of the Cement Mason BLD and HWY work performed in Logan County pursuant to Local 18's collective bargaining agreements with the applicable employer associations.

6. Accordingly, the parties agree that the Department shall amend the prevailing wage rates for the Cement Mason classifications in Logan County as follows:

7. BAC Local 8 agrees to the foregoing Cement Mason wage and fringe benefit rates and withdraws, or otherwise waives, any objection to the Department establishing the Local 18 rates identified above as the prevailing wage rates for the Cement Mason BLD and HWY classifications in Logan County at issue in this proceeding.

8. The Department shall revise its prevailing wage determination for Logan County consistent with this Consent Decree and shall publish the corrected Cement Mason BLD and HWY rates through the Department's normal publication process.

9. The rate determination shall apply effective upon publication.

10. By entering into this Consent Decree, the parties resolve all issues raised in Petitioners' August 6, 2026, Objection and Request for Section 9 Hearing concerning the Cement Mason BLD and HWY classifications in Logan County and hereby agree that Local 18 shall participate in future prevailing wage surveys for the classification of Cement Mason BLD and HWY in Logan County.

11. The parties waive:

- a. Further procedural steps before the Administrative Law Judge concerning the issues resolved by this Consent Decree; and

- b. Any right to challenge or contest the validity of this Consent Decree or the Decision and Order entered in accordance herewith.
