Admin. Code 120.100, *et seq.*, the Notice of Webex Hearing issued thereunder, and all parties being on notice during the pre-hearing conference, the undersigned issues this Order:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. In connection to Respondents' September 3, 2026 Motion to Dismiss Objectors' Objection and Request for Hearing and Deny its Request for Extension of Time ("Motion");
2. The Objectors' Request to Stay or Continue the briefing schedule, as asserted at pre-hearing, relevant to the Motion in this matter is Denied; and
3. Accordingly, the Objectors' Response, if any, to the Motion shall be filed **via email on or before Friday, September 11, 2026 at 5:00 p.m.**; and
4. The Respondents' Reply to the Objectors' Response, if any, shall be filed **via email on or before Tuesday, September 15, 2026 at 5:00 p.m.**
5. Thereafter, a decision based on the record shall be issued by the undersigned on the Motion, which will contain any necessary information for subsequent action(s).
6. Additionally, although interested participants filed Petitions to Intervene (4) by September 2, 2026 pursuant to the undersigned's August 20, 2026 Order;

7. Given the unresolved threshold concerns and Motion before the undersigned, the respective Petitions to Intervene in the above captioned matter are held in abeyance pending the resolution of the Motion.
8. All parties and interested participants have agreed and consent to electronic service in the above captioned matter.
9. **The hearing date of SEPTEMBER 25, 2026 @ 9:30 a.m. is hereby stricken, in accordance with the parties' notification via email to the undersigned, of the parties' written consent to waive the Act's 45-day hearing requirement.**
