

**OBJECTIONS AND REQUEST FOR SECTION 9 HEARING**

Petitioners Mid-America Regional Bargaining Association, Curran Contracting Company, Geneva Construction, and IHC Construction, by and through the Mid-America Regional Bargaining Association Executive Director, submit these objections to the prevailing wage schedule published by the Illinois Department of Labor on its website, and request a hearing pursuant to Section 9 of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act (820 ILCS 130/9), and in support of state as follows:

1. The Mid-America Regional Bargaining Association (“MARBA”) is a multi-employer trade association representing several other trade associations in the union construction industry in an eleven-county region of Northern Illinois.
2. MARBA represents the following trade associations in collective bargaining and post-collective bargaining contract administration with several trade unions in the eleven-county region of Northern Illinois: Chicagoland Associated General Contractors (“CAGC”), Illinois Road and

Transportation Builders Association ("IRTBA"), Great Lakes Construction Association ("GLCA"), Underground Construction Association of Illinois ("UCA"), Masons Contractors Association of Greater Chicago ("MCAGC"), Chicagoland Crane Association ("CCA"), and the Chicago Outer Belt Contractors Association ("COBCA") (hereinafter referred to collectively as "MARBA Member Associations").

3. The MARBA Member Associations that comprise MARBA membership count amongst their members hundreds of union contractors that perform work on various public works projects throughout the State of Illinois, specifically in the following counties: Boone, Cook, DeKalb, DuPage, Grundy, Kane, Kankakee, Kendall, Lake, McHenry, and Will.

4. Curran Contracting Company ("Curran") is a union contractor based in Crystal Lake, IL that bids and does work on public works projects in various Illinois counties, including the counties listed in paragraph 3.

5. Geneva Construction Company ("Geneva") is a union contractor based in Aurora, IL that bids and does work on public works projects in various Illinois counties, including the counties listed in paragraph 3.

6. IHC Construction ("IHC") is a union contractor based in Elgin, IL that bids and does work on public works projects in various Illinois counties, including the counties listed in paragraph 3.

7. Each of the above referenced contractors pay prevailing wage rates as determined annually by the Department of Labor.

8. Section 9 of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act states, "The Department of Labor shall during the month of June of each calendar year, investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages for each county in the State." 820 ILCS 130/9.

9. The Illinois Administrative Code governing the Department defines the prevailing wage rate as "the hourly cash wages plus fringe benefits ... most frequently (numerically occurring), in the county

in which the public work is performed, to employees engaged in public works.” 56 Ill. Adm. Code 100.22.

10. During the period June 1, 2017 through May 31, 2018 (the “Measurement Period”) MARBA’s signatory contractors employed thousands, if not hundreds of thousands, of hours of union brick masons, carpenters, cement masons, laborers, material tester I, material tester II, millwrights, operating engineers, pile drivers, stone masons, and trucks drivers in various counties.

11. Curran, Geneva, and IHC are signatory to several of the MARBA collective bargaining agreements (“CBAs”) with various trade unions, including but not limited to, the: Bricklayers Allied District Council 1 (“Bricklayers”), Chicago Regional Council of Carpenters (“Carpenters”), Operative Plasters’ and Cement Masons International Association Local 502 (“Cement Masons Local 502”), Operative Plasters’ and Cement Masons International Association Local 11 Areas 161, 362, and 638 (“Cement Masons Local 11 Areas 161, 362, and 638”), Construction and General Laborers District Council of Chicago and Vicinity (“Laborers”), International Union of Operating Engineers Local 150 (“Operators or IUOE Local 150”) and Teamsters Joint Council No. 25 (“Teamsters”).<sup>1</sup>

12. Historically, in furtherance of the Section 9 process, MARBA has submitted Prevailing Wage Certification Forms listing collectively bargained wage rates and fringe benefits for brick masons, carpenters, cement masons, laborers, material tester I, material tester II, millwrights, operating engineers, pile drivers, stone masons, and trucks drivers certified in conjunction with the Bricklayers, Carpenters, Cement Masons, Laborers, Operators, and Teamsters (collectively the “Unions”) to the Illinois Department of Labor (“Department”) in May or June of each year. (See Exhibit A).

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<sup>1</sup> The MARBA Collective Bargaining Agreements which were submitted electronically during the Department’s electronic survey process total hundreds of pages. They are not attached to this Petition but can be sent electronically to the Department prior to a hearing.

13. Historically, the Prevailing Wage Certification Forms submitted by MARBA and the Unions contained information not only relating to wage rates and fringe benefits but also the counties, job classifications, and the number of workers covered.

14. Historically, MARBA, in conjunction with the Unions, submitted copies of its collective bargaining agreement(s) ("CBA(s)") in support of the information contained on the Prevailing Wage Certification forms.

15. MARBA performed this service for its association members and those contractors signatory to the MARBA agreements so contractors would be relieved of the administrative burden of completing almost identical forms, the risk of clerical or other errors would be reduced, and the Department would not be inundated with much of the same information as submitted by MARBA and the Unions.

16. As recently as 2015, the Department accepted the Prevailing Wage Certification forms and CBA(s) submitted by MARBA and the Unions.

17. In the past, after receipt of the information submitted by MARBA and the Unions, and as recently as 2015, the Department published prevailing wage rates consistent with information submitted by MARBA and the Unions.

18. Consistent with past practice, in June 2018, MARBA submitted information to the Department for its electronic prevailing wage survey. The information submitted by MARBA to the Department in June of 2018, other than being submitted in electronic form, was consistent with information submitted in prior years.

19. With respect to the 2018 prevailing wage investigation process, the Department of Labor actively sought out MARBA's participation in said process. To wit, MARBA received an email from the Department of Labor on May 31, 2018, asking for MARBA to participate in the Department's electronic prevailing wage survey. (See Exhibit B).

20. MARBA participated in the 2018 prevailing wage survey by following the instructions contained in the survey as presented by the Department.

21. On or about August 15, 2018, the Department published the following prevailing wage schedule on its website:

*The rate schedules linked to on this page contain the prevailing wage rates required to be paid for work performed on or after August 15, 2018 on public works projects in each County. Pursuant to 820 ILCS 130/4, public bodies in each County that have active public works projects are responsible for notifying all contractors and subcontractors working on those public works projects of the change (if any) to rates that were previously in effect. The failure of a public body to provide such notice does not relieve contractors or subcontractors of their obligations under the Prevailing Wage Act, including the duty to pay the relevant prevailing wage in effect at the time work subject to the Act is performed.*

22. The rates as listed are littered with inconsistencies from county to county, trade to trade, and classification.

23. The inconsistencies are a result of the Department alternating between which survey responses were accepted and deemed to have “prevailed”.

24. In some instances, it relied on submissions made by MARBA and the Union to set the prevailing wage rate.

25. For instance, in Boone County, under the Material Tester I and Material Tester II job classifications, the Department accepted either the Laborers Local Chicago A and B and/or MARBA rates submitted (it is impossible to discern which groups submissions received more weight and were accepted).

26. In other instances, the Department relied on contractor submissions to set the prevailing wage.

27. For example, in Boone County under the Laborer classification the Department accepted the submission of Rock Road Companies.

- a. The Department set the prevailing wage for Boone County based on the rate submitted by Rock Road Companies. In relying on a contractor submission, the Department



discounted the long-standing practice of relying on submissions made by MARBA and the Laborers Union.

- b. Moreover, Rock Road Companies did not list a foreman rate. By not listing a foreman rate and being the submission that prevailed, the Department did not list a foreman rate. The MARBA/Laborers CBA contains a foreman rate of \$43.47 as evident by the submission of both MARBA and the Laborers.
- c. Had the Department continued with the long-standing practice of relying on the MARBA and Union submissions (in this case the Laborers), the Department would have listed the foreman rate of \$43.47.

28. There are several other examples of the Department flip-flopping between methodologies used to ascertain the prevailing wage rates.

29. For instance, the Department accepted submissions from B.E.T.O.N. Construction under the contractor survey for Brick Mason in Cook County.

- a. B.E.T.O.N Construction is a MARBA signatory contractor and listed a foreman rate of \$50.80.
- b. Twelve (12) other contractors also responded to the survey and listed varying rates. Two (2) of the contractors, Jimmy Z Masonry Corp. and Febel Brothers, Inc. listed foreman rates of \$50.81. Those two contractors had more hours combined than B.E.T.O.N Construction, yet their submissions were not counted.
- c. Jimmy Z Masonry Corp and Febel Brothers, Inc. are also MARBA signatory contractors.
- d. Moreover, MARBA, the MCAGC (a MARBA member association), and the Bricklayers all responded to the survey and listed a Foreman rate of \$50.81, yet their submissions were not counted.

- e. Additionally, B.E.T.O.N. submitted a Saturday overtime rate at 2.00 times the hourly rate.
  - f. Every other contractor, regardless if they were a MARBA signatory contractor or not, in addition to MARBA, the MCAGC, and the Bricklayers, listed a Saturday overtime rate of 1.50 times the hourly rate, yet B.E.T.O.N.'s Saturday overtime rate prevailed.
30. Examples such as the ones described in paragraphs 26-28 are abound in the electronic survey responses.
31. Under the Cement Mason Local 502 classification for Cook County, Pan-American Construction Company prevailed.
- a. While their submissions mirrored the rates submitted by both MARBA and Cement Masons Local 502, another contractor listed a journeyman rate of \$100.00 per hour and no fringe benefits rates.
  - b. Had this contractor prevailed, the journeyman rate of \$100.00 per hour and no fringe benefits rates would have made it nearly impossible for other contractors to bid work competitively in Cook County under the Cement Mason Local 502 classification.
32. As another example, under the Operating Engineer Building Class I rate in Cook County, II in One Contractors, Inc. submitted information via the Department's prevailing wage electronic survey.
- a. The rates submitted by II in One Contractors, Inc., a MARBA signatory contractor, did not reflect a foreman rate.
  - b. Moreover, the rates submitted by II in One Contractors, Inc., again a MARBA signatory contractor, reflected fringe benefit rates that differed from the rates submitted by MARBA and IUOE Local 150, yet the rates submitted by II in One Contractors, Inc. prevailed.

- c. The rates submitted by MARBA and IUOE Local 150 both reflect the same rates which show the same fringe benefits rates as well as a foreman rate. Although these submissions were accepted by the Department, they did not prevail.
33. However, under the Operating Engineers DuPage County Building Class IV and Class VI rates, the submissions made by MARBA and IUOE Local 150 were accepted and those rates did prevail, including the fringe benefits rates submitted by both parties.
34. Under the Operating Engineers DuPage County Building Class II rates, the contractor that prevailed reported eight (8) hours and listed health insurance rates of \$0.73 per hour and pension/retirement rates of \$1.28 per hour. This same contractor listed no training rates and listed "other" rates of \$34.44.
  - a. The total of all the fringe benefits submitted by that contractor equals \$36.45.
  - b. MARBA and IUOE Local 150's fringe benefits submissions, when totaled together, equal \$38.15.
  - c. The rates submitted by the contractor that prevailed under the Operating Engineer DuPage County Building Class II classification are \$1.70 less than the rates submitted by MARBA and Local 150.
  - d. Again, the fringe benefits rates submitted by MARBA and IUOE Local 150 prevailed under the DuPage County Building Class IV and Class VI, but they did not prevail for the DuPage County Building Class II.
35. As another example, in the Lake County Carpenter classification, Happ Builders, Inc. submitted information with respect to wages and fringe benefits.
  - a. Happ Builders, Inc. is signatory to the CBA between MARBA and the Carpenters.
  - b. Happ Builders, Inc. did not list a foreman rate and did not list a rate for training.

- c. However, under the MARBA/Carpenters CBA, those rates are \$49.35 and \$0.63 respectively.
  - d. Both MARBA and the Carpenters listed the foreman rate and training rate in their responses to the Department, at \$49.35 and \$0.63 respectively.
36. Under the Lake County Lather classification, the Department accepted responses from both MARBA and the Carpenters.
- a. MARBA and the Carpenters were the only two groups to respond to that classification and county, as such, their rates prevailed (again it is impossible to discern which groups rates actually "prevailed").
  - b. The rates listed by both MARBA and the Carpenters contained a foreman rate and training rate.
  - c. Despite accepting the rates listed by both MARBA and the Carpenters for the Lather classification in Lake County, a classification contained in the MARBA/Carpenters CBA, the Department did not accept the submissions by MARBA and the Carpenters for the Carpenters classification in Lake County thereby leading to a discrepancy in Lake County wage and fringe benefits rates for the Carpenters classification.
37. As another example, in Lake County, the Department accepted rates for wages and fringe benefits submitted by MARBA and IUOE Local 150 for Class III under the HWY designation. The rates submitted by both entities prevailed although it was not possible to ascertain what weight each entity was given when submitting their rates to the Department.
- a. Under the Operating Engineer Lake County Class IV HWY, the Department received three (3) responses. One (1) from a contractor survey and two (2) from a union survey (MARBA and IUOE Local 150).

- b. Despite MARBA and IUOE Local 150 submitting rates for Class III and Class IV which mirrored each other, the Department used the rates submitted by the contractor for Class IV HWY even though the rates for wages and fringe benefits are lower than what was submitted by MARBA and IUOE Local 150 for Class III.

38. In McHenry County, under the Laborer classification the Department accepted a contractor submission.

- a. The contractor submission did not contain a foreman rate.
- b. The contractor submission contained a training rate.
- c. MARBA and the Laborers also submitted information for the same classification in McHenry County.
- d. The rates submitted by both MARBA and the Laborers mirrored each other.
- e. The rates submitted by MARBA and the Laborers differed from the contractor's submission in that the MARBA and the Laborers submissions had a foreman rate and a training rate lower than the contractor's submission.
- f. MARBA and the Laborers also submitted information for the Material Tester II classification in McHenry County.
- g. There were no contractor submissions for the McHenry County Material Tester II rate. As such, the prevailing rate was determined based on the response submitted by MARBA and the Laborers (although it was not discernible as to what group's submissions prevailed).
- h. Despite accepting the MARBA/Laborers submissions for Material Tester II, the Department did not consider their submissions when ascertaining the prevailing wage rate for the Laborer Classification in McHenry County.

39. As another example, the Department relied on a contractor survey for the Will County Truck Driver Class I classification.
- a. The contractor did not list a foreman rate.
  - b. MARBA and the Teamsters both submitted wage and fringe benefits rates for the Will County Truck Driver Class I classification, as well as Class II, Class III, and Class IV.
  - c. Those submissions contained a foreman rate.
  - d. The Department accepted the MARBA and Teamster rates for Class III and Class IV and those rates prevailed, but the rates submitted by MARBA and the Teamsters for Class I or Class II did not prevail.
40. There are several other instances in which discrepancies exist throughout the prevailing wage rate posting and prevailing wage rate survey responses in the eleven counties MARBA covers across multiple trades and classifications.
41. Where the Department ignored MARBA's submission in favor of a single contractor's submission, the Department did not establish the prevailing wage based on the wage paid to the majority of workers in those classifications working on public projects in those counties. 56 Ill. Adm. Code 100.22
42. The 2018 proposed prevailing wage rates do not reflect the wages and fringe benefits "paid generally, in the locality in which the work is being performed, to employees engaged in work of a similar character on public works." (See 820 ILCS 130/2).
43. The Petitioners therefore object to this prevailing wage schedule and request the rates be modified.
44. Moreover, on August 21, 2018 the Department published its "methodology" with respect to the way it "investigated" and "ascertained" the prevailing wage rates for 2018.

45. The methodology used by the Department to investigate and ascertain the prevailing wage rate in June 2018 deviated from the methodology used in previous years in investigating and ascertaining the prevailing wage rate.

46. The methodology used by the Department to investigate and ascertain the prevailing wage rate in June 2018 deviated from the methodology used in previous years in investigating and ascertaining the prevailing wage rate and was unreasonable and arbitrary in the following ways.

a. The Department failed to inform the public that the unwritten part of the “methodology” was that in counties and classifications where a trade association or union submitted, and a contractor also submitted, the Department ignored the trade associations’ and unions’ submission out of hand in favor of the contractor’s submission. Thus, the Department’s policy was to use trade association and union submissions only where no contractors made a submission.

i. The Department applied this unstated policy for Bricklayers, Carpenters, Cement Masons, Laborers, Operators, and Teamsters in Boone, Cook, DuPage, Grundy, Kane, Kankakee, Kendall, Lake, McHenry, and Will Counties and for many other trade classifications and counties throughout Illinois.

b. Even where multiple contractors submitted, the Department made no effort to determine whether the contractor with the largest number of hours was at all representative of the prevalent community of like contractors and paid wages and fringes benefits generally, in the locality in which the work is being performed, to employees engaged in work of a similar character on public works.

47. The Department acted unreasonably and arbitrarily in the way that it implemented its new arbitrary and unreasonable policy. For years, the Department and union contractors had relied on the trade associations and unions to submit wage data on behalf of the contractors. This

practice mutually benefited both the Department and the contractors because contractors were relieved from the administrative burden of completing and submitting virtually identical forms, the Department was not flooded with numerous identical submissions from each constituent member, and the risk of clerical or other errors were reduced.

48. This practice of trade associations and unions submitting area-wide wage data to the Department and the Department accepting and utilizing those submissions when establishing the prevailing wage rates existed for so long as to establish a well-known custom and practice in the Illinois construction industry.

49. The Department made little or no effort to inform the hundreds of contractors and trade associations throughout Illinois of the Department's new and secret policy of ignoring the submissions of trade associations and unions where at least one contractor also submitted, prior to implementing that new and secret policy.

50. The Department made little or no effort to solicit Illinois union contractors to abandon the well-known custom and practice of delegating this administrative task to their trade associations and devote the considerable administrative resources to this new regulatory obligation on an individual basis.

51. As a result of the Department's failure to inform the construction community of Department's new and secret methodology and the new obligation to submit data on an individual basis, Department unreasonably and arbitrarily insured that the data that it received and on which it would base its decisions would not accurately reflect the wages and fringe benefits generally, in the locality in which the work is being performed, to employees engaged in work of a similar character on public works in the various classifications in the various communities throughout Illinois.




52. The Petitioners object to the arbitrary and unreasonable methodology used by the Department in investigating and ascertaining the prevailing wage rates for 2018 and to the arbitrary and unreasonable way in which the new methodology was rolled out to the Illinois commercial construction community.
53. The rates for the tradespeople referenced in paragraph 10, performing work on public works projects in the State of Illinois, took effect under CBA's negotiated at an arm's length between MARBA and the Unions with rate increases effective on June 1 each year the agreement is in effect.
54. By completing the electronic survey sent to MARBA in June 2018, the documentation provided to the Department of Labor by MARBA, at the behest of the Department of Labor, show that contractors signatory to the MARBA and Union collective bargaining agreements pay the rates contained in those CBAs while performing work on public works projects in the various counties.
55. MARBA signatory contractors, including the Petitioner Contractors, are at a competitive disadvantage resulting from the Department's posting of incorrect rates obtained using a faulty methodology.

For the reasons set forth above, Petitioners object to the prevailing wage schedule posted on the Department's website on or about August 15, 2018, as well as the arbitrary and unreasonable methodology so used and respectfully request: 1) a hearing on these objections; 2) a recalculation of the 2018 prevailing wage rates for the following counties, trades, and classifications: Boone, Cook, DeKalb, DuPage, Grundy, Kane, Kankakee, Kendall, Lake, McHenry, and Will; brick masons, carpenters, cement masons, laborers, material tester I, material tester II, millwrights, operating engineers (all classes), pile drivers, stone masons, and trucks drivers (all classes); 3) an order declaring the 2018 prevailing wage rates determination to be improper, preventing the Department from using its new and arbitrary rule

and ordering the Department to reset within 14 days the 2018 prevailing wage rates based on the rates submitted by MARBA as contained in the CBAs between MARBA and the various Unions.
