Dear Director Kleinik;

My office is legal counsel to Plumbers and P. ipefitters Local IOI ("Local JO1"). Th. is letter constitutes a Section 9 Written Objection and Request for Hearing pursuant to 820 ILCS 130/9, regarding the Wage Classification for "pipefitter" in the County of Monroe.

The basis for the objection is as follows:

I. On July 15, 2020, the Illinois Department of Labor ("Depa11ment") posted a prevailing wage determination for Momoe County (the "Determination") which contained the following wage rates for the classification of "pipefitter."

Base	\$40.5C
Foreman	\$44.5C
Health/Welfare	\$8.29
Pension	\$IO.JC
Training	\$1.55

- 2. The above rates are those reflected in the collective bargaining agreemen1 negotiated for the pipefitter classification by Steamfitters Local 439 ("Local 439").
- 3. Local 101 and Local 439 each have jurisdiction over separate portions of Monroe County in regard to the perfonnance of pipefitting work. Specifically, Local 439 has jurisdiction over the Western portion of Monroe County, and Local 101 has jurisdiction over the Eastern portion of Momoe County.
- 4. Locals IOI and 439 have defined the Western portion of Momoe County as all portions of the county west of a line which begins at the point where Highway 158 enters Monroe County from St. Clair County; such line shall extend due south until it intersects with Highway 3; from that point, the line follows Highway 3 until it exits Monroe County near the town of Red Bud. The parties have defined the Eastern portion of Monroe County as all portions of Monroe County not contained in the Western portion of the county, as defined above.
- 5. Work performed by members of Local I OJ constitutes the majority of the work in the pipefitting trade performed in the Eastern portion of MomoeCounty.

- 6. The wage rates for "pipefitte rs" contained in the Detenni nation set forth in paragraph I, above, are accurate for the Western portion of Momoe County, which is the julisdiction of Local 439.
- 7. The wage rates for "pipefitters" contained in the De tenn ination set forth in paragraph 1, abo ve, are <u>not</u> accurate for the Eastern pollion of Monroe County, which is the jurisdiction of Local 10 I.
- 8. The wage rates for the "pipefitter" classification for the Eastern portion of Monroe County should be:

Base	\$40.55
Foreman	\$43.05
Health/Wel fare	\$10.20
Pension	\$6.30
Training	\$1.25

These rates are contained in the collect ive bargaining agreement negotiated by Local 10 I.

9. Local IO I has conferred with Local 439 and Local 439 does not object to the change in the Depa11meot's Determination as set forth below.

For the above reasons, Local IO I requests the following changes to the "pipefitter" Determination for Monroe County:

- l. Monroe County should be divided into Western and Eastern politions, as defined in paragraph 4, above.
- 2. The existing "pipefitter" Determination as set forth in paragraph I, abo ve, should be the determination for the Western pollion of Monroe County.
- 3. The "pipefitter" wage rate negotiated in Local 1 O 1 's collect ive bargaining agreement, as set folth in paragraph 8, above should be the prevailing wage for the "pipefitter" classification in the Eastern portion of Monroe County.

If the above-requested changes are not made, Local IOI respectfully requests a heating on this matter pursuant to 820 [LCS 130/9.
