- 4. Subpoenas for the attendance and testimony of witnesses shall be filed on or before AUGUST 22, 2023. The subpoena shall show on its face the name and address of the party at whose request the subpoena was issued.

Each party and intervenor shall provide all parties and the undersigned with a witness list containing the names/professional address/phone numbers for hearing of any witnesses who may be called to testify at hearing on or before AUGUST 29, 2023. The disclosure must provide subjects/topics on which the witness will testify. the disclosure must sufficiently give reasonable notice of the testimony. The purpose of this disclosure is to prevent unfair surprise at hearing with creating an undue burden on the parties before the hearing.
- 7. All parties/intervenors shall have a duty to seasonably supplement all disclosures.
- 8. Any disclosure dispute is to be addressed with the opposing party/intervenor prior to filing any motion. Evidence demonstrating said outreach will be required before a motion will be entertained regarding the same.
