CONSENT DECREE

Objectors, Stanley Simrayh, a member of the International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 150, AFL-CIO and the International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 150, AFL-CIO ("Local 150"), and Respondents Jane R. Flanagan, Director of the Illinois Department of Labor and the Illinois Department of Labor ("Department") resolve the above-captioned matter pursuant to 56 Ill. Admin. Code 120.540 as follows:

- 1. This matter arises under the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act ("IPWA"), as amended, 820 ILCS 130/0/01, et seq.
- 2. Pursuant to Sections 4 and 9 of the IPWA, Petitioners timely filed written objections to the prevailing wage rates effective July 13, 2023 pertaining to the Mechanic-Welder description in Operating Engineer Class 1 on Heavy/Highway projects and in Operating Engineer Class 1 on Building projects in the counties of Rock Island, Mercer, the west half of Henry, and the portion of Whiteside that includes all territory in the west portion of Whiteside County from the fifth (5th) sectional line east of Morrison, Illinois, running directly north and south and sought to establish a new rate and class.
- 3. Pursuant to Sections 4 and 9 of the IPWA, the Department scheduled a hearing on Petitioner's objections, issued a Notice of Hearing to Petitioners, and provided notice of the hearing to the public by posting the date, time, location, and other pertinent information regarding the Section 9 hearing on Petitioner's objections on IDOL's official website.

- 4. It is determined that in the counties of Rock Island, Mercer, the west half of Henry, and the portion of Whiteside that includes all territory in the west portion of Whiteside County from the fifth (5th) sectional line east of Morrison, Illinois, running directly north and south, the prevailing wage classifications and rate determinations published (posted) by the Department shall include a new classification for Mechanic-Welder. The Department shall recognize:
 - a. Class 10 Mechanic-Welder on Operating Engineer Building type trade work at a wage rate of \$40.50 with no changes to fringe benefit rates, consistent with the Industrial, Commercial, Residential and Building Construction Agreement Between International Union of Operating Engineers, Local No. 150 and Quad City Builders Association ("QCBA Collective Bargaining Agreement");
 - b. Class 10 Mechanic-Welder on Operating Engineer Heavy/Highway type trade work at a wage rate of \$40.50 with no changes to fringe benefit rates, consistent with the Heavy and Highway Agreement Between International Union of Operating Engineers, Local No. 150 and Associated Contractors of the Quad Cities ("ACQC Collective Bargaining Agreement").
- 5. It is determined that Mechanic-Welder will be removed from Class 1 on Operating Engineer Building type trade work and from Class 1 on Operating Engineer Heavy/Highway type trade work and replaced with the aforementioned classes and wage rates, consistent with the QCBA Collective Bargaining Agreement, and the ACQC Collective Bargaining Agreement, respectively.
- 6. The prevailing wage and fringe benefit rates applicable to Class 10 Mechanic-Welder on Operating Engineer Heavy/Highway work shall be those rates as set forth in the QCBA Collective Bargaining Agreement. Rates for the counties of Rock Island, Mercer, the west half of Henry, and the portion of Whiteside that includes all territory in the west portion of Whiteside County from the fifth (5th) sectional line east of Morrison, Illinois, running directly north and south, as of July 13, 2023, are the following:

Base Wage: \$40.50

Overtime M-F, Sat: 1.5x base rate Overtime Sunday: 2x base rate Overtime Holiday: 2x base rate

Foreman: \$42.50

Health & Welfare: \$20.40

Pension: \$13.60 Vacation: \$2.00 Training: \$2.05

7. The prevailing wage and fringe benefit rates applicable to Class 10 Mechanic-Welder on Operating Engineer Heavy/Highway work shall be those rates as set forth in the QCBA Collective Bargaining Agreement. Rates for the counties of Rock Island, Mercer, the west half of Henry, and the portion of Whiteside that includes all territory in the west portion of Whiteside County from the fifth (5th) sectional line east of Morrison, Illinois, running directly north and south, as of July 13, 2023, are the following:

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Health & Welfare: \$20.40

Pension: \$13.60 Vacation: \$2.00 Training: \$2.05

- 8. The rate determinations shall apply effective upon publication, but no later than October 15, 2023, through the next subsequent rate determination by the Department. Subsequent rate determination periods shall be subject to Section 4(a) and Section 9 rate ascertainments and determinations.
- 9. The Decision and Order disposing of this proceeding shall have the same force and effect as an Order made after a full hearing.
- 10. The parties waive:
 - a. Further procedural steps before the Administrative Law Judge; and
 - b. Any right to challenge or contest the validity of this Consent Decree or the Decision and Order entered in accordance herewith.
