ORDER

THIS MATTER, THIS MATTER came before the undersigned Administrative Law
Judge on August 27, 2025, pursuant to the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS

130/11a (“Act” or “PWA”), in accordance with Article 10 of the Illinois Administrative Procedure Act, 5 ILCS 100/10-5 through 10-70, and the Illinois Department of Labor’s Rules, 56 Ill. Adm. Code §120.400 et seq. The Order further arises out of (1) the Agreed Motion to Continue filed August 14, 2025, concerning the September 19, 2025 hearing date, and (2) the Petitions to Intervene filed by the Laborers’ International Union of North America (“LIUNA”) Local 1 and the Chicago Laborers’ District Council; the Great Plains Laborers District Council, including LIUNA Local 32 in DeKalb County, Illinois; and the International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 150, AFL-CIO.

The Illinois Department of Labor has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties pursuant to Section 11a of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/11a, and 56 Ill. Adm. Code §120.400 et seq. Having reviewed the filings, considered the record, and being fully advised in the premises, the undersigned Administrative Law Judge issues this order:

1. Petitions to Intervene filed by:
 - Laborers’ International Union of North America (“LIUNA”) Local 1 and the Chicago Laborers’ District Council;
 - Great Plains Laborers District Council, including LIUNA Local 32 (DeKalb County); and
 - International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 150, AFL-CIO,

are hereby GRANTED. The granted Interveners are recognized as parties of record with full rights to participate in these proceedings.

2. The Petition to Intervene filed by the Mid-America Carpenters Regional Council is DISMISSED due to Petitioner’s failure to appear.
3. The telephonic pre-hearing conference set for August 27, 2025, is continued to September 5, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. The pre-hearing shall address, including but not limited to:
 - simplification of issues;
 - the necessity or desirability of amending pleadings or documents for clarification, simplification, or limitation;
 - stipulations and admissions of fact and the authenticity of documents;
 - limiting the number of witnesses;
 - the propriety of prior mutual exchange of prepared testimony or exhibits; and
 - such other matters as may expedite disposition of the proceedings and ensure a just resolution.

4. The Parties, both in writing and verbally, have waived any demand for a hearing within forty-five (45) days of the filing of Objections under the Act.
5. The undersigned Administrative Law Judge shall initiate the conference call.
6. All Parties consent to service by electronic mail. All future filings shall be served simultaneously upon all parties of record and the Administrative Law Judge via email, unless otherwise ordered.
7. Failure of any party to comply with this Order, including participation in the continued pre-hearing, may result in appropriate sanctions, including dismissal of objections, denial of intervention, or entry of default, as authorized by 56 Ill. Adm. Code §120.
