MOTION TO RECONSIDER AND VACATE DISMISSAL

The Mid-America Carpenters Regional Council by its attorneys respectfully requests that the Dismissal Order entered on August 27, 2025 be reconsidered and vacated, and state the following in support:

1. The Mid-America Carpenters filed its Petition to Intervene in this matter on August 14, 2025 and Counsel's appearance was filed on August 21, 2025.

2. The Mid-America Carpenters have a crucial interest and potential objections to the establishment of classifications sought by the Petitioner in the matter. Counsel for the Petitioner and for the Mid-America Carpenters have engaged in communications in an effort to resolve any difference between the parties.

3. The matter was scheduled for hearing on August 27, 2025. Counsel for the Mid-America Carpenters failed to appear and as a result its Petition to Intervene was dismissed.

4. Counsel for the Mid-America Carpenters records do not reflect receiving notice of the August 27, 2025 hearing. It appears that the notices for the hearing were circulated on the same day that Counsel filed his appearance which might explain the lack of notice. We assure the judge that any scheduling errors will be rectified and will not occur in the future.

5. No party to this proceeding will be prejudiced by the vacation of the Dismissal Order and by allowing the Mid-America Carpenters an opportunity to resume its discussions with counsel for the Petitioner in an effort to resolve any objections to the relief being requested.
